Homework Policy - World History

- 1. Late work is not accepted for points! You have ONE pass for the SEMESTER to turn in any assignment of your choice, excluding any major projects/quizzes/exams. This assignment may be turned in ONE day after the due date without penalty.
- 2. Homework is due immediately upon the beginning of class. Most assignments are due the following class period after they are assigned. *Zero late work is accepted!*
- 3. Homework is to be completed independently, *before class!* This means that I do not want to see students rushing through homework right before the bell rings; this rarely results in adequate work.
- 4. Cheating will not be tolerated! If you are caught cheating or a homework assignment/quiz/exam, etc., you will not receive credit for it. Your homework pass MAY NOT be used for the assignment in which you are caught cheating.
- 5. As of the unit over Islam, I will not be collecting a homework notebook. This may or may not change later in the semester. Homework is due on the designated date.
- 6. Absent work: absent students will be responsible for meeting with the teacher at an appropriate time in order to review absent work. Absent class work to homework is due the next class meeting. If a student is absent for a test/quiz, the test may only be made up during Academic Advisory. The student has two Ac. Lab periods to make up the test. Failure to do so within this time will result in a zero.
