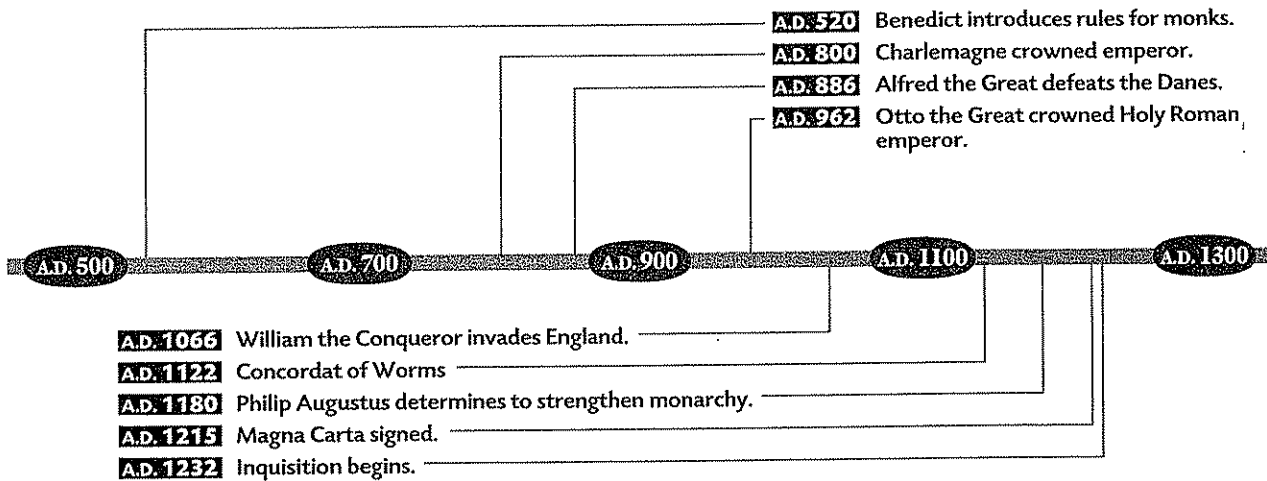


# Time Line
